



WYALKATCHEM PET CEMETERY

Location: Cemetery Road (Opposite the Rubbish Tip entrance).

The Pet Cemetery was established as a Community Service by the Rotary Club of Wyalkatchem.

All residents are welcome to use this Cemetery to bury their beloved pet. It is free to bury your pet there.

The Pet Cemetery has two rows for plots, the first row is filled, and the second row has pegs in the ground, marking where graves should go.

Chicken wire should be placed below the surface of covering soil to discourage disturbance by other animals.

A roll of chicken wire can be located inside the gate on the left hand side.

Guidelines for burying your pet at the Cemetery:

- Pet owners are responsible for all aspects of the burial
- Animals larger than dogs are **NOT** to be buried at the Cemetery
- Numbered sites only to be used in sequence and kept in line
- Buried pets should be covered by a minimum of 50cms of soil
- Place chicken wire below the surface of covering soil

No burial records are kept. Users are encouraged to mark the graves of pets and should do so to prevent inadvertent reuse of a site.
