

THE ROAD DISTRICTS ACT, 1919.

Wyalkatchem Road Board.

THE Wyalkatchem Road Board doth hereby make and publish the following By-law:—

Hawker's License.

1. No person shall hawk foodstuffs or merchandise, or expose or offer for sale, any goods whilst travelling through the Wyalkatchem Road District without having first obtained the necessary Hawker's License.

2. Every person who hawks goods for sale shall be required to carry the requisite scales for the weighing of such goods when selling same.

3. The fee for a Hawker's License shall be ten shillings per annum.

4. Every person who does, permits, or suffers any act or thing contrary to this By-law shall on conviction for every offence, breach, or neglect be liable to a penalty not exceeding Ten pounds (£10) sterling.
