The Shire is now able to accept your household batteries for recycling at both the Shire office and the CRC.

Bring your old batteries in and we will gladly take them from you. This project will help divert dangerous chemicals from landfill and send them to the correct facility for recycling.

There is no charge, it's a completely free service. All you need to do is tape them, collect them in a glass jar and when you have a few collected bring your old batteries in and we will do the rest for you! Simple as that!



Tape the terminals of your batteries to prevent risk of fire

Check accepted batteries



Put them in a glass container and keep out of reach of children

Learn about safety



B-cycle them at your nearest Drop off point & take your container home for reuse

I am looking forward to a wonderful 24/25 with all the pool improvements happening at the Wyalkatchem pool.


Lastly, I would like to thank the Shire for the never-ending care and support.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Local Public Notice is hereby given that the Shire of Wyalkatchem is intending to make the following Local Law.

Bush Fire Brigades Local Law

The purpose of the local law is to regulate the appointment, employment, payment, dismissal and duties of bush fire control officers; the organisation, establishment, maintenance and equipment with appliances and apparatus of bush fire brigades to be established and maintained by the local government; and any other matters affecting the exercise of any powers or authorities conferred and the performance of any duties imposed upon the local government by the *Bush Fires Act 1954* that are to be dealt with by a local law;

The effect is that the matters that the *Bush Fires Act 1954* requires to be regulated by local law are dealt with by a local law.

The proposed Local Law may be inspected at the Shire of Wyalkatchem during normal office hours. An electronic copy can be downloaded from the Shires website at www.wyalkatchem.wa.gov.au
