
The steps on the Goods Shed have been replaced thanks to our maintenance man Gary, and footpath repairs have now been completed in several streets in town.

# **Greenwaste Collection**

Next week the Shire will be doing a green waste collection in town streets.

Please note this is green waste only – this will be picked up by hand so size appropriate please. Please make sure the pile of green waste is on the verge at the start of the commencing week allocated to your street.

The commencing date and streets are listed below:

Week commencing 27th May - Piesse Street & Honour Ave Week commencing 3rd June - Johnston Street & Flint Street Week commencing 10th June - Thurstun Street & Wilson Street

Week commencing 17th June -Scott Street & Swan Street & McLean Street

Week commencing 24th June- Slocum Street & Lindsay Street Week commencing 1st July- Ritches Street & Grace Street

#### Items we WILL collect

Pruning's up to 1.5m in length and 15cm in diameter.

• Loose leaves and grass clippings in boxes or bags.

#### **Items we will NOT collect**

- Dug out lawn
- General waste, junk or white goods
  - Sand or soil materials
  - Stumps or palm logs
  - Weeds and root materials
  - No more than 2 cubic metres.
