

#### **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Local Public Notice is hereby given that the Shire of Wyalkatchem is intending to make the following Local Law.

#### **Bush Fire Brigades Local Law**

The purpose of the local law is to regulate the appointment, employment, payment, dismissal and duties of bush fire control officers; the organisation, establishment, maintenance and equipment with appliances and apparatus of bush fire brigades to be established and maintained by the local government; and any other matters affecting the exercise of any powers or authorities conferred and the performance of any duties imposed upon the local government by the *Bush Fires Act 1954* that are to be dealt with by a local law;

The effect is that the matters that the *Bush Fires Act 1954* requires to be regulated by local law are dealt with by a local law.

P&G have been out at the Cemetery and staked up the cottonwoods which are growing beautifully.


P&G Staff have attended a chemical course and now have AQF3 Chemical accreditation.
